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Hello JFS families,

What a wild week it has been! I know that there have been many factors that have contributed to stress for some of our school community members this week from sickness to weather, there has been a lot to manage. As a school community (staff and students), we have been talking a lot about intent vs impact when we are processing our actions at school.

The intent of keeping students/staff home from school for remote days on Thursday and Friday was to reduce traffic on the roads and to keep people safely in their homes. The impact is that some families lose out on income and this causes additional stress. Unfortunately, SAU9 is one of the largest geographical districts in the state of New Hampshire. Therefore, even if we are safe in North Conway and we all have power and the roads are passable, that is not to say that the roads in Hart's Location or out in Eaton are the same.

The intent of having an optional early release or delayed release on Monday 4/8 due to the eclipse was to prevent students from getting off a bus in complete darkness and to reduce the number of students that may unsafely view the eclipse without supervision. We hoped to reduce the impact on families by offering an early and late dismissal option. Although, I realize that there are a limited number of families that will be impacted by there being no Project SUCCEED on Monday.

As a school principal, I do not make the decisions about snow days/remote days, etc. But, I am part of a team that provides input at times. If you share your concerns with me, I will do my best to share your perspective with the district's decision makers. Your family's safety and wellbeing is at the forefront of all of our decisions. Your children's learning is a very close second priority.

I firmly believe that we are better together. Please continue to keep the lines of communication open and constructive. Student, staff, and family feedback is critical for our school to continue to grow and thrive. I wish you all a safe and warm weekend.

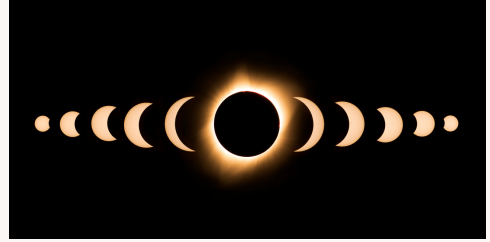
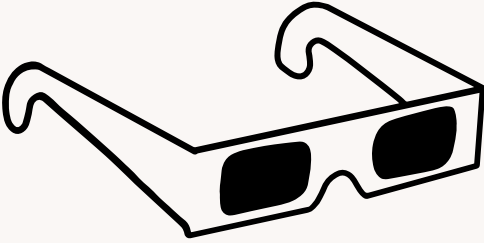

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# Solar Eclipse



On Monday April 8, 2024 there will be a solar eclipse in New Hampshire during the approximate hours of 2:10-4:30 pm. The town of Conway will observe the eclipse at about 98% obscuration. This is a significant educational opportunity for our students and staff to experience a lifetime event.

It is expected that the eclipse will bring many visitors to northern New Hampshire, Maine, and Vermont. The solar eclipse path of totality (100% obscuration) begins a little north of Berlin, New Hampshire up through Sherbrooke, Canada. The tourist impact may impede traffic to the north and to a lesser extent the Mount Washington Valley. There is also concern for traveling during the peak eclipse viewing time frame.

Some of our staff members and schools have been preparing for this event to help students experience the eclipse in a safe manner. Each school has approved eclipse glasses for each student to view the eclipse safely. **NO ONE** should view the eclipse without proper eyewear!

All schools in SAU 9 will have a modified end of the day schedule on April 8, 2024. Because the eclipse is occurring during the typical dismissal time, there are some modifications to the school day that we would like to inform you of. Standard bus departure will **NOT** take place at the regular time and we will be offering the alternative schedule.

## **Conway Elementary Schools (PTS, JFS, CES)**

- **Elementary students may be picked up early by parents/guardians at or before 1:45 pm for students choosing not to stay for the eclipse. Please dismiss students through the main office.**

**OR**

- **Elementary students may stay at their school under the supervision of staff until 4:30pm. For students choosing to stay, there will be bus transportation provided at the close of the eclipse period or students can be picked up by parents at 4:30pm.**

**AND**

- **There will not be Project SUCCEED programming on April 8th.**

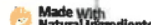
